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Teacher Training Policy

- Faculties cannot enrol themselves directly; they have to be enrolled by their respective Institute and Teacher for training on a particular programming language/ software.

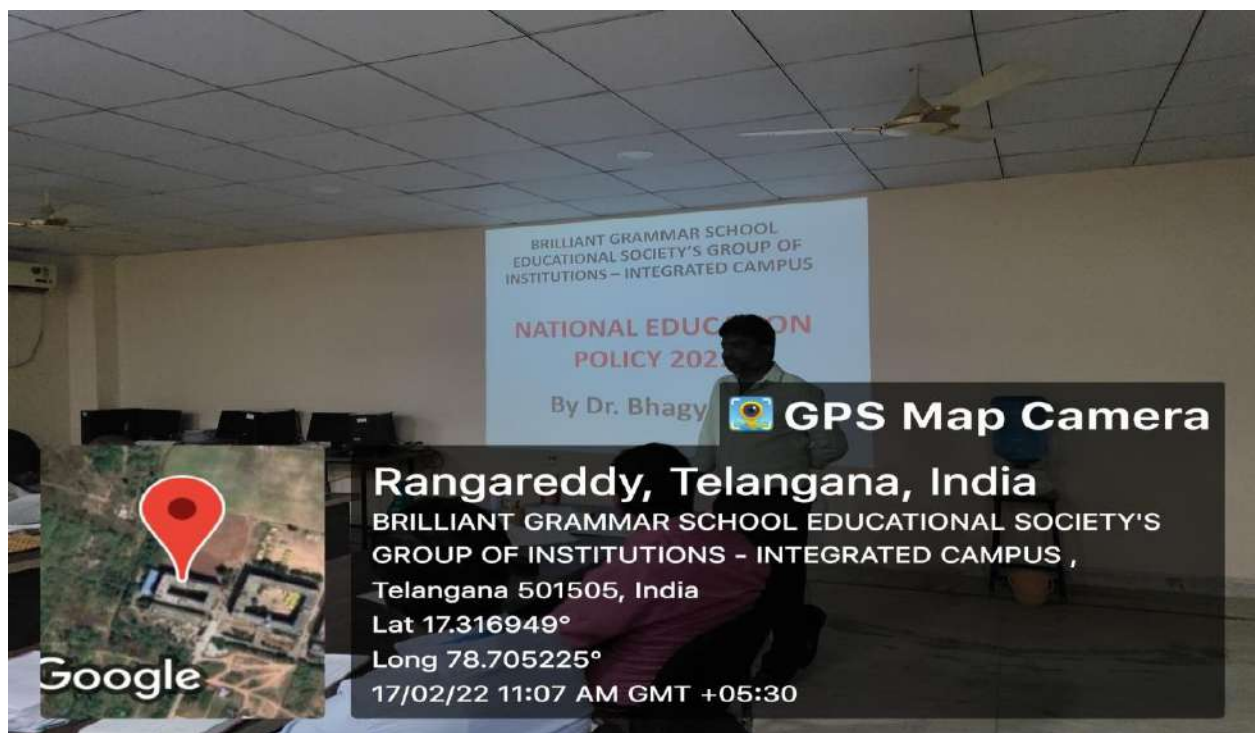
National Initiative for Technical Teachers Training
